

## APS Chapters/Affiliates Web Site Awards Entry Details

1. This web site awards program is open to all APS Chapter and Affiliate organizations that sponsor a web site for their own group and/or sponsored stamp show.
  2. There is no charge to enter the competition.
  3. Submissions will only be accepted from an organization's webmaster or officer by using this entry form. One entry form per web site.
  4. Multiple entries for different web sites by the sponsoring organization will be allowed.
  5. A web site may be entered in one of three categories:  
CLASS I: Organization – a site about one or more APS Chapter/Affiliate groups  
CLASS II: Stamp Show – site about an APS Chapter/Affiliate sponsored stamp show  
CLASS III: Combo – site that deals with both an organization and its sponsored stamp show
  6. Deadline for all entries is **June 1** of the competition year.
  7. A panel of 2 or 3 APS appointed judges will evaluate each site for its merits against a score sheet of optimum qualities. The panel will come to a consensus on awarding the site one of five award levels: Gold, Vermeil, Silver, Silver Bronze and Bronze.
  8. Score sheet criteria include general sections on content, structure and navigation, visual design, function, and interactivity. A sample score sheet can be found at <http://stamps.org/cac/index.htm>.
  9. Each entry will stand on its own merits. An unlimited number of each award level will be available.
  10. Web sites must be operational on a 24 hour basis during the judging period of June 1 through July 15 or are subject to disqualification at the discretion of the judging panel.
  11. All award levels presented by the judging panel are final.
  12. Awards will be announced at Stampshow in August. A representative from each organization with an entry is encouraged to attend if possible.
  13. Entrants will receive a score sheet with comments on how the award was attained and suggestions on future improvements.
  14. Entrants will also receive an electronic awards badge designating the award level received and competition year. Badges may be displayed perpetually on the entered web site's home page when received.
